Letter from Carol S. Kochman dated April 5, 2004

- 19-1 Local jurisdictions often require the undergrounding of electric distribution lines. However, overhead transmission lines are not prohibited and are regulated by the CPUC rather than local jurisdictions (Please see response to Comment 1-13). The proposed Viejo System Project would involve the installation of new transmission lines along the existing transmission corridor.
