

Notice is hereby given that the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) has released a Notice of Preparation (NOP) of an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Moorpark-Newbury 66 kV Subtransmission Line Project for public review and comment. The EIR will address potential direct, indirect, and cumulative impacts of the construction, operation, and maintenance of the proposed project and alternatives. Information to be included in the EIR also will be based on input and comments received during the NOP scoping period, which is open from March 26, 2014 until 5:00 p.m. on April 25, 2014. The workshop (6:30 p.m.-7:00 p.m.) will address the CPUC's processes for reviewing the project application and analyzing environmental impacts of the project as well as how the public can participate. The scoping meeting will be held from **7:00 to 8:30 p.m.** All members of the public are invited to attend. Following the scoping period, the CPUC will prepare a Draft EIR that will consider comments received. Decision-makers, responsible and trustee agencies under CEQA, property owners, and interested persons and parties will have an opportunity to comment on the Draft EIR when it is published for review.
