### Project Description

#### *Substation*

1. The Mascot PEA's Project Description mentions new subtransmission line segments that would connect the Mascot substation to the Hanford-Liberty and the Goshen-Hanford 66 kV lines. Please provide the number of line segments that would connect the substation to each line.
2. Land Acquisition and Access Rights – It is our understanding that the right-of-way requirements described in Section 3.4 of the PEA may need to be adjusted. Provide a description of right of way and acquisition requirements as they differ from the PEA.
