Decision 11-07-056, Ordering Paragraph 8, directed Commission Staff to hold a technical workshop to discuss providing authorized third parties with access to customer data via the utility backhaul. Additionally, the decision directed the utilities to propose a common data format, consistent with national standards, and propose eligibility criteria and a process for determining eligibility of third parties. The utility applications proposing third party access are due six months from the mailing of the decision (or January 30, 2012).
