o CLEC s are competitive local phone companies, which provide local phone service and compete with ILECs in ILECs franchise territory.

o Flat Rate (FR) Service: A rate plan by which customer pays a single monthly amount for unlimited local telephone calls

o Measured Rate (MR) Service: A rate plan by which customer pays for the number of calls and the duration of each local call.

o Lifeline rates are for households whose annual income falls into the following categories during June 1, 2008 through May 31, 2009.
