SUBJECT: El Casco System Project – CPUC’s Partial Underground Alternative

This letter is in response to the Draft Environmental Impact Report for the El Casco System Project prepared for the California Public Utilities Commission, San Francisco California SCH #2007071076. Specifically to address the Partial Underground Alternative that is recommended as environmentally superior the proposed project as well as other alternatives.

The Board of Directors of Sun Lakes Country Club Homeowners Association is responsible for the maintenance of the community and the operation of the community golf course. When the project was initially proposed there were mixed opinions regarding the option of installing either: (i) overhead power lines or (ii) underground power lines. Many residents of the community felt that the overhead power lines were acceptable and many residents were supportive of the underground installation.

The reason for responding to the Draft Environmental Impact Report is to establish the facts surrounding the community comments. The Board of Directors determined that it would not take an official position on behalf of the community. As of this writing the Board maintains a neutral position on this matter.

However, it appears from the language in the Draft Environmental Impact Report that because of comments received from the Sun Lakes Country Club community the partial underground alternative was developed and explored. We would like to record to reflect that this alternative and any consequences of this alternative were developed and proposed by a number of residents of the community and may not reflect the views or opinions of the entire community.
