I just spoke with Elizabeth Hornback who is a contract employee of Imperial Avenue Transit through a company called First Group. Her company manages the bus routes for IVT. She said that there is one bus that makes one trip per week to Ocotillo and stops in front of the Post Office on Imperial Highway. I explained there will be an increase in traffic on Imperial due to the Sunrise Powerlink construction. She said that as long as the construction does not block the street or the bus stop, she has no issue with the construction traffic.
