The final determination of local jurisdiction permitting requirements will depend on final engineering, final site surveys, and construction requirements. Permits and approvals may be obtained from the counties of Riverside and San Bernardino and the cities of Banning, Beaumont, Calimesa, Colton, Grand Terrace, Loma Linda, Palm Springs, Redlands, San Bernardino, and Yucaipa.
