

Matinee Pricing Next Steps (Commissioner Reports)

Summary of Existing Possible Forums for Matinee Rates:

- PG&E's existing Phase II General Rate Case Application is A.16-06-013 (presently assigned to Commissioner Peterman and ALJ McKinney). PG&E has requested its matinee rate, if approved, to go into effect in January 2018.
- SCE's existing Rate Design Window is A.16-09-003 (presently assigned to ALJ Roscow and President Picker). No scoping memo issued yet. Typically rates would go into effect in mid to late 2018.
- SDG&E's existing Phase II proceeding is A.15-04-012 (assigned to Commissioner Florio and ALJ McKinney). Hearings in that case are scheduled for November 2016.
- The Time of Use Rulemaking is R.15-12-012, currently assigned to President Picker and ALJ McKinney. The rulemaking will update the time of use periods but does not fully overlap with the matinee pricing proposal, since both SCE and SDG&E have a more dynamic reverse Demand Response component.

Next Steps:

I intend to issue a revision to my Proposed Decision for consideration at the November 10, 2016 meetings that does the following:

- Defers consideration of the PG&E tariff to A.16-06-012;
- Approve the SCE and SDG&E pilot in this proceeding;
 - The revised PD would modify the pilots offerings to commence in Spring 2018 and go through Spring 2019
- Add direction that SCE and SDG&E can expand beyond the 100-200 participating customers if it remains within its budget cap
- Add a requirement to have the evaluations more broadly consider perspectives of eligible but non participating customers (to act as a point of comparison).
