Subject: PRA Aliso

Greetings: Please provide to me under the Cal Public Records Act and Art 1, Sec 3, any and all writings (as defined in the PRA) reflecting communications between any CPUC Commissioner, staff of any such Commissioners regarding the Aliso Canyon natural gas storage field (the field) and related facilities, including any reports of any leaking at the field for the period January 2014 to date.

Also please provide any and all Aliso Canyon Turbine Replacement Project Construction Non-Compliance Reports relating to the occurrence of any leakage causing accident or event related to any leakage at the field. Please provide any reports from Southern California Gas Company or Southern California Electric or any other source sent to or from any CPUC Commissioner, staff of such Commissioner or any other CPUC agent, officer and employee regarding the cause of the leakage at the Aliso Canyon natural gas storage field. Please include any records of related telephone briefings or discussions, scheduled meetings, or notes taken at any such meetings or discussions.

Also please provide any writings related to any inspections by CPUC Safety and Enforcement of the Aliso Canyon natural gas storage field since January 2012 to date. Please include any writings since January 2012 to date to or from Gas Safety and Reliability Branch Program Manager Kenneth Bruno or any of his staff or subordinates related to any leakage at the field.

Finally, please provide any writings to or from any Commissioner, staff member of such Commissioners regarding whether the CPUC should open an Order of Investigation (OII) regarding the leakage at the field. Please also include any related communications between any CPUC Administrative Law Judge and any agent, officer or employee of Southern California Gas Company and Southern California Edison.

The previously issued CPUC malfeasance report is provided to assist the CPUC in responding to this PRA. Thank You, Mike Aguirre
