SUBJECT: CPUC / DOGGR Selection of RCA firm

To Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas):

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), in consultation with the Department of Transportation's Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration and the Department of Gas and Geothermal Resources (DOGGR), has selected Blade Energy Partners (Blade) to perform the independent Root Cause Analysis (RCA) that was directed in my December 14, 2015 letter. Please ensure the following details are executed:

1. Blade shall be brought under contract and provided access to the incident site at Aliso Canyon no later than January 29th 2016
2. SoCalGas shall make the incident site at Aliso Canyon available to Blade
3. SoCalGas shall equip an office trailer on site that has adequate space and internet access and printers for the Blade team and CPUC investigators
4. SoCalGas shall preserve all physical evidence needed for the RCA, including the well casing – SoCalGas shall not seal the top of the well with concrete until Blade extracts the casing for examination
5. SoCalGas shall not direct the work of Blade
6. SoCalGas shall promptly respond to all inquiries, data requests, and additional resource requests, including providing specialists, as needed to support the RCA
7. Please provide a copy of the final contract with Blade once executed
8. SoCalGas shall ensure that all Blade's findings and recommendations (including drafts) are submitted to the CPUC, DOGGR, and SoCalGas simultaneously
