

1 I, SUSAN BULLIS, declares as follows:

2 1. I am over the age of 18 and am a resident of San Bruno, California. I make this
3 declaration based on my personal knowledge, except for any matters stated on information and
4 belief, which matters I believe to be true. If called upon as a witness, I could and would competently
5 testify to the matters stated herein.

6 2. On the evening of September 9, 2010, I was at a nurses' meeting in Sunnyvale. My
7 husband, Gregory, my son, William, my mother-in-law, Lavonne, and our dog, Lucky, were at our
8 home located at 1690 Claremont Drive in San Bruno. I had no idea when I said goodbye to my
9 family that morning before my husband and I went to work and my son went to school, that it would
10 be the last time I would ever see any of them.

11 3. I learned while I was at my work meeting that there had been an explosion and
12 fire in our neighborhood. I saw pictures of our house engulfed in flames on the television, and I
13 noticed that my husband's truck was parked outside our home, and my mother-in-law's car was
14 parked in the driveway. I knew in my heart that my family was inside that burning home.

15 4. I remember the next few days and weeks as a hellish blur. I remember meeting
16 the coroner at the temporary home where I was staying in South San Francisco, as she swabbed my
17 cheek to take a DNA sample so that they could identify the bone fragments they had found as my
18 husband and my son. I remember learning from the coroner that my son's remains were so badly
19 charred, that they could not identify his body from the DNA sample I provided. I remember
20 dreaming that my son was alive, and the brief moment when I woke up and believed it to be true,
21 only to remember the next moment that he was gone, and being crushed by that realization all over
22 again. I remember raw pain, and grief more palpable and overwhelming than I had known was
23 possible. I remember the sheer hopelessness I felt.

24 5. On September 9, 2010, I lost my husband, my son, my mother-in-law, my dog, my
25 house, and everything I owned. Dealing with any one of those things would be extremely difficult
26 for any person. Dealing with all of that loss at once is more than any person should have to bear in
27 a lifetime.

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6. Every day is a struggle for me. I will miss my family every minute for the rest of my life. There is an emptiness inside of me that I have learned will never be filled. PG&E took my family away from me, and there is nothing that anyone can ever do that will ever get them back.

1 I, BETTI MAGOOLAGHAN, declares as follows:

2 1. I am over the age of 18 and am a resident of San Bruno, California. I make this
3 declaration based on my personal knowledge, except for any matters stated on information and
4 belief, which matters I believe to be true. If called upon as a witness, I could and would competently
5 testify to the matters stated herein.

6 2. On the evening of September 9, 2010, I was at my home located at 1611
7 Claremont Drive in San Bruno, with my three young children, Charlotte, Gabriella, and Liam, sitting
8 down to have dinner. I was 8.5 months pregnant with my fourth child at that time. My husband,
9 Bill, was still at work in San Francisco. Suddenly, we heard an explosion and saw the towering
10 inferno just outside our home.

11 3. I scooped up my younger children and took Charlotte's hand and ran as fast as I
12 could. We did not have time to get dressed or even put on shoes. I ended up carrying the children
13 nearly one mile to safety, as the fire burned all around us.

14 4. As a result of the fire, my daughter Charlotte sustained serious and painful blisters
15 on the bottom of her feet due to fleeing barefoot from the fire. My daughter Gabriella suffered
16 increased intermittent extropia as a result of the fire. My son lost his voice for an entire week after
17 the fire, as a result of screaming in terror when the explosion occurred and crying for hours
18 thereafter.

19 5. My family's home and almost all of our possessions, including wedding photographs,
20 wedding gifts, children's artwork, and souvenirs from China for our adopted daughter, were all
21 destroyed in the fire. My family was displaced for 16.5 months as a result of the explosion, and only
22 just moved back to our home, which we decided to rebuild.

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
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6. I, as well as my family, have suffered tremendously from this incident. In addition to having to flee for my life, I have suffered from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder, insomnia, and acute stress as a result of the explosion. We, especially my children, have had and continue to have trouble sleeping and concentrating, and experience nightmares and flashbacks.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct.

1 I, ROBERT PELLEGRINI, declares as follows:

2 1. I am over the age of 18 and am a resident of San Bruno, California. I make this
3 declaration based on my personal knowledge, except for any matters stated on information and
4 belief, which matters I believe to be true. If called upon as a witness, I could and would competently
5 testify to the matters stated herein.

6 2. I, along with my wife Tina, son Joseph and brother Edward were at home on
7 September 9, 2010. My home was located at 1701 Claremont Drive, San Bruno, California. We had
8 just finished dinner when we heard an explosion and saw the towering inferno just outside our home.
9 My home was instantaneously engulfed in flames.

10 3. All four of us ran outside through the backyard to escape the fire. We heard other
11 families screaming attempting to escape the fire. Knowing it was going to be extremely hot, I
12 attempted to turn on a garden hose to soak our bodies before attempting to further retreat. However,
13 there was no water pressure.

14 4. When my family made a run for it, I had lost my brother Edward. I thought I lost
15 my brother in the fire. We were reunited later that evening.

16 5. My family's home and all of our possessions, including items passed down from
17 my now deceased parents were all destroyed in the fire. My family is still displaced as a direct result
18 of the explosion. We have decided to rebuild our home and one and a half years later, we are still
19 living in someone else's home as the rebuild project has not been completed.

20 6. I, as well as my family, have suffered tremendously from this incident. In addition
21 to having to flee for my life, I have been diagnosed with Acute Traumatic Stress Disorder and Post-
22 Traumatic Stress Disorder. I have had and continue to have trouble sleeping and concentrating at
23 work. Photographs of not only my and my wife's life, but that of my parents and son have all been
24 destroyed.

25 I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing
26 is true and correct.
