The Commission is committed to a decisionmaking process that is impartial, consistent, and transparent, maintains integrity at all levels and is consistent with the law. Commissioners are committed to being actively engaged in the decisionmaking process.

Therefore, the Commission will ensure that:

- a) The procedures, practices, and rules for Commission decisions are documented, understandable and conveniently accessible to the public and interested parties.
- b) All decisionmaking documents (the “record”) are logged and available to the public to the extent allowed by law, and improved means to access the record are implemented at the earliest feasible date.
- c) The Commission’s decisionmaking process enables and encourages the parties, the public, and governmental entities to participate actively in developing the record in Commission proceedings.
