To: Telecommunications Carriers Serving Customers Approved for California Teleconnect Fund

Re: California Teleconnect Fund Administrative Letter No. 23 – Clarifying Appendix C of Decision 15-07-007

Pursuant to Decision 15-07-007 of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), the elimination of the California Teleconnect Fund (CTF) discount on wireless data plans effective October 1, 2015, applies to all Federal E-rate eligible participants. Appendix C of Decision 15-07-007 inadvertently omitted Libraries under the first section of Wireless Data plans CTF Discount phase down. This Administrative Letter clarifies (as shown below) that beginning October 1, 2015, participating telecommunications carriers may no longer provide the CTF discount to wireless data plans to both Schools and Libraries, unless the participant received a cost-effective exemption from the Federal E-rate program. Telecommunications carriers must provide documentation of the E-rate exemption to the CPUC staff when filing claims for reimbursement.
