

Industrial Energy Efficiency: Strategic Plan Update and Industrial Action Plan

Published in 2008 by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), the California Energy Efficiency Strategic Plan outlines energy goals and efficiency strategies for key market sectors.

As noted in the [2010 decision adopting the Strategic Lighting Plan](#), “Energy Division - in coordination with utilities, state agencies, a variety of entities in buildings and industry, and a wide range of trade groups and nonprofit organizations - is creating action plans for the Plan sectors. These action plans are designed to: (a) identify the key actions required to achieve Plan milestones; (b) secure leaders (hereafter, “champions”) to achieve these actions; (c) track and report on progress. The action plans are being designed to achieve milestones identified in the Plan by working with Plan champions. In the near-term, the Commission will serve as a central organizational point for Plan champions, via the energy efficiency web portal, offline facilitation of the champions network, and tracking progress towards milestones.”

The Industrial Action Plan (IAP) is a way to support and operationalize the industrial goals of the Strategic Plan, as well as a way of reviewing and updating the goals as needed. The first of three stakeholder meetings to launch the IAP will be held on August 8 at the CPUC Auditorium in San Francisco. This meeting will be comprised of stakeholders across California. This workshop will be an opportunity to review the current industrial chapter of the Strategic Plan, discuss proposed updates to the industrial chapter, provide feedback and learn more about action plan development.
