



California Public Utilities Commission Wants to Hear from You About Cal Water's Rate Request

The CPUC is holding a Public Participation Hearing in San Carlos on California Water Service Company's (Cal Water) rate request. This free public meeting will be on Tuesday, October 4, at 6 p.m., at the San Carlos Library, 610 Elm St., Community Room (2nd Floor), in San Carlos.

If Cal Water's rate request is approved by the CPUC, Cal Water would increase rates for water service by \$94,838,100 or 16.5% in test year 2017; \$22,959,600 or 3.4% on January 1, 2018; and \$22,588,200 or 3.3% by January 1, 2019; and adopting other related rulings and relief necessary to implement the CPUC's rate-making policies.

Please bring your comments – and your neighbors! – to express your views to the CPUC about Cal Water's request to increase its rates. What do you think of Cal Water's service? What are your thoughts on Cal Water's rate request? The CPUC wants to hear from you!
