



California Public Utilities Commission Wants To Hear From You About PG&E's Rate Request

The CPUC is holding two Public Participation Hearings in San José on PG&E's 2017 General Rate Case request to increase its rates, effective January 1, 2017. These two free public meetings will be on Wednesday, July 27, 2016, 1 p.m. and 6 p.m., at the San José Scottish Rite Center, 2455 Masonic Dr., Room 3, San José.

If PG&E's rate request is approved by the CPUC, PG&E would increase revenue \$333 million in 2017, followed by an additional increase of \$469 million in 2018 and, an additional increase of \$368 million in 2019.

Please bring your comments – and your neighbors! – to express your views to the CPUC about PG&E's request to increase its rates. What do you think of PG&E's service? What are your thoughts on PG&E's rate request? The CPUC wants to hear from you!
