Applicant	Project Plan Description
Golden State Connect Authority (37 applications)	Loan Loss Reserve (LLR) program funds will be used to secure tax-exempt bond issuance for portion of total project area financing. Securitization provided by LLR will allow applicant to access lowest interest rate possible so that maximum investment can be made in fiber broadband network deployment, thus providing access to broadband to the greatest number of unserved and underserved addresses.
City of Fort Bragg	A Municipal Broadband Utility designed, constructed, operated and maintained by the City of Fort Bragg will provide 100% of premises within city-limits access to digital infrastructure (underground conduit, fiber, and electronics) through a fiber-to-the-premise network, with speeds between 1-10 Gbps. The network connects to California Middle Mile Infrastructure, and leverages existing AT&T backhaul for redundancy.
