



# The California Teleconnect Fund

for eligible Public Schools, Private Schools, Libraries, 2-1-1 Providers, Community Colleges, and Government Hospitals

**THE CALIFORNIA TELECONNECT FUND (CTF)** for eligible Public Schools, Private Schools, Libraries, 2-1-1 Providers, Community Colleges, and Government Hospitals provides a 50% discount on monthly recurring broadband and advanced communication services.

## Who is eligible?

- Public and Private K-12 schools and instructional annexes with a County District School Code (CDS).
- Libraries, Library annexes, kiosks and bookmobiles.
- Government Operated County or Municipal Hospitals and California Critical Access Hospitals (CAAH).
- California Community Colleges.
- 2-1-1 Providers must be approved by Commission Resolution.\*

## How does it work?

- Your organization submits a CTF application through their eCAP account.
- CTF staff reviews the application and sends a determination letter to the organization
- Organization provides their service provider with the CTF Approval Letter
- Service provider applies a 50% discount to the organizations bill

## Requirements

### Public, Private Schools and their annexes:

- ☐ An active CDS code

### Private Schools:

- ☐ An active CDS code
- ☐ IRS 501(c)(3) Letter
- ☐ Documentation of annual revenues below \$50 million, such as IRS Form 990 or Pro Forma IRS Form 990

### Libraries and their annexes:

- ☐ A letter from the California State Librarian

### Library bookmobiles:

- ☐ Vehicle Identification Number (VIN)
- ☐ License Plate Number

### Government Hospitals:

- ☐ Be owned and operated by municipal or county government or hospital district
- ☐ Have a valid healthcare license and identification number from the California Department of Public Health and/or the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services

### Critical Access Hospitals:

- ☐ Be a member and be listed on the California Hospital Association website under California Critical Access Hospital Network

### Community Colleges:

- ☐ The California Community Colleges Management Information Services (MIS) Code

*\*2-1-1 Providers must be approved by Commission resolution. Organizations that receive referrals from 2-1-1 providers, Community Based Organizations (CBOs), and Healthcare Community Based Organizations (HCBOs) may qualify and have alternate eligibility requirements.
