The CPUC has established a new grant opportunity for Regional Tribal Consortia to apply for technical assistance funding for Tribal governments seeking to develop broadband infrastructure. This opportunity is based on the existing grant program for Regional Consortia, which assists broadband infrastructure grant applicants in developing projects or applying for funding. At the request of the Mechoopda Tribe, the CPUC is holding a Regional Workshop to present on the grant opportunity and receive feedback from Tribes about the development of Regional Tribal Consortia.
