 - Jim: Mid 30%.
 - Marcie: For the customers who were pre-emptively renewed, will they keep their initial anniversary date, or will their anniversary date be readjusted to June 30?

- David: Providers who do not currently use SPIA, will their customers be able to take advantage of the CalFresh recertification process?

I will need to research the steps the consumer group will have to do to avail themselves of this funding for outreach for ACP. This funding is not available to SP but available to consumer groups.
