Dear Mr. Morris:

This notice is to advise the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) that CCP LLC (also known as CCO SoCal I, LLC) operating as Charter Communications is applying for an Amendment to reduce its boundaries and cease providing microwave video service to various areas of Tulare County within the next 90 days. These areas are in low growth-low density remote areas of Tulare County and are currently served by dated microwave technology. The costs associated with maintaining the microwave technology (and distribution system), complying with new EAS equipment requirements and quality customer service does not meet our return on investment model. Frankly, the cost to maintain and service the systems exceeds the revenues. We will continue to serve the other areas of Tulare County where we currently have a franchise. We are notifying the County and customers of this decision.
