IN-PERSON WORKSHOP FOR RULEMAKING 23-04-006 ABOUT VIDEO FRANCHISING RULES

August 17, 2026 starting at 10:00 a.m.

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) will hold an in-person workshop to engage in an interactive discussion on issues such as consumer protection rules, adjudication of complaints, reporting requirements, enforcement and penalties, and revisions to the application and renewal processes as part of implementing the Digital Infrastructure and Video Competition Act of 2006 (DIVCA).

DIVCA streamlined the video franchising process by assigning the franchising authority to just one government entity, the CPUC. The CPUC is the sole entity responsible for determining which companies can qualify to become state video franchise holders in California.
