VIOLATIONS

You are hereby cited with having violated section(s) of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and a Commission General Order (G.O.) as described below. These violations occurred during the period April 16, 2022, through August 25, 2023.

- Operated as a charter-party carrier after revocation of its authority, in violation of Pub. Util. Code section 5379 [72 counts];
- (2) Engaged one (1) driver without enrollment in the Department of Motor Vehicles [DMV] Employer Pull Notice Program [EPN], in violation of Pub. Util. Code section 5374 (a)(1)(D) and 5381 and G.O. 157-D, part 5.02 and California Vehicle Code (CVC) section 1808.1. [1 count].

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above violations are documented in the attached Investigation Report, which consists of carrier's records and substantiating documents obtained from other sources.

RESPONSE

You are hereby called upon to answer this citation on or before <u>November 8, 2023</u>. By way of such answer, you may either:

- Pay a fine of \$6,000 pursuant to P.U. Code Section 5378. (Submit your check or money order payable to California Public Utilities Commission using the attached *Citation Agreement*. Upon payment, the fine will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund and the Commission staff will deem the matter closed, or
- (2) Contact the Supervisor below to make payment arrangements, or
- (3) Contest this Citation by filing an Appeal. See attached document "*How to File an Appeal and Instructions for Filing a Notice of Appeal and Certificate of Service for a Citation Appeal.*"

If you fail to respond by November 8, 2023, you will be in default and will have forfeited your right to appeal the Citation. In addition, your operating authority will be immediately suspended and may be subsequently revoked pursuant to Resolution ALJ-187. The Commission may also act through a civil or criminal proceeding to recover any unpaid fine and ensure compliance with applicable statutes and Commission orders.

NARRATIVE

On July 25, 2023, I was assigned to investigate Carefree Natomas Limited Partnership (hereafter referred to as Carefree Senior Living) for operating a bus while its authority was revoked.

VIOLATIONS

The investigation disclosed Carefree Senior Living violated the following provisions of the Public Utilities Code (Pub. Util. Code) and Commission General Orders (GO) from April 16, 2022, through August 25. 2023:

• Operated as a charter-party carrier after revocation of its authority, in violation of the Pub. Util. Code Section 5379. [72 counts]

Pub. Util. Code Section 5379 states "After the cancellation or revocation of a permit or certificate...it is unlawful for a charter-party carrier of passengers to conduct any operations as a carrier."

On June 6, 2023, the Department of California Highway Patrol's (CHP) Enforcement and Planning Division sent a memorandum to the California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) Director of the Consumer Protection and Enforcement Division [Attachment 1]. The memorandum explained that on May 2, 2023, the CHP's Motor Carrier Safety Unit of Valley Division completed a terminal inspection of Carefree Senior Living. The inspection revealed that Carefree Senior Living was operating a tour bus without a valid permit or certificate issued by the CPUC in violation of Section 5387 of the Pub. Util. Code.

The Transportation License and Analysis Branch (TLAB) database shows Carefree Senior Living's authority was suspended on April 18, 2022, and then revoked on October 14, 2023, for failure to pay the annual Public Utilities Commission Transportation Reimbursement Account (PUCTRA) fee for 2021 [Attachment 2]. The carrier's authority was reinstated on June 8, 2023 [Attachment 3]. On August 18, 2023, I sent the Chief Operating Officer (COO) of Carefree Senior Living, Ms. Carrie Barone, a Data Request notice [Attachment 4]. The documents provided in response to the Data Request notice show that the carrier was operating for 72 days without authority. An email sent by Ms. Barone verifies the vehicle was used for non-medical transport [Attachment 5]. This non-medical transport of their clients requires Carefree to have a TCP Z permit. Table 1 and Attachment 6 contains representative samples of pre/post-Trip Vehicle Inspection Sheet (Daily Bus Report) of their non-medical trips are shown in bold.

• Engaged one (1) driver without enrollment in the California Department of Motor Vehicles' (DMV0 Employer Pull Notice Program [EPN], in violation of the Pub. Util. Code Sections 5374 (a)(1)(D) and 5381, G.O. 157-D Part 5.02, and the California Vehicle Code (CVC) Section 1808.1. [1 count]

Pub, Util. Code Section 5374 (a)(1)(D) states "each applicant participates in a program to regularly check the driving records of all persons, whether employees or subcarriers, operating vehicles used in transportation for compensation

Pub. Util. Code Section 5381 states "the Commission may supervise and regulate every charter-party carrier of passengers in the State".

G.O. 157-E Part 5.02 states "every carrier shall enroll in the "Pull Notice Program" of the Department of Motor Vehicles."

CVC Section 1808.1 states "...the employer of a driver who drives any vehicle specified in subdivision (k) shall participate in a pull-notice system."

A search of the DMV online EPN database shows Carefree Senior Living, EPN requester code **1000**, enrolled in the EPN Program on March 18, 2023 and is currently "Active". On August 25, 2023, the carrier enrolled Mr. Survine Herman Anthony as a driver in the EPN Program **[Attachment 6]**. However, the driver logs provided by Ms. Barone shows that Mr. Survine had been driving since June 5, 2023. Table 2 and **Attachment 7** contain representative samples of Pre/Post-Trip Vehicle Inspection Sheet (Daily Bus Report) signed by Mr. Survine.

On May 2, 2023, the California Highway Patrol, Valley Division Motor Carrier Safety Unit, completed a terminal inspection of Carefree Natomas, LP, TCP 30738, located at 5601 Natomas Boulevard, Sacramento, CA 95838. The inspection revealed that the carrier operated a tour bus without a valid permit or certificate issued by the Public Utilities Commission. Consequently, the carrier is deemed to be in violation of Section 5387 of the California Public Utilities Code.

As a result of the foregoing, we are forwarding a copy of the CHP 343, Safety Compliance Report/Terminal Record Update, for your review and any action deemed appropriate. 

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

CPUC Order of Suspension

This is notice from the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) that the operating authority listed on this letter is suspended effective **April 16, 2022**.

Failure to pay annual fees (PUCTRA) 2021

Unless the suspension was requested voluntarily, if the reason(s) for the suspension are not resolved within 180 days, on **October 13**, **2022**, the operating authority will be revoked. Voluntary suspensions may stay in effect without becoming revoked until the operating authority expires.

After the cancellation or revocation of a permit or certificate, or during the period of its suspension, or after the expiration of its permit or certificate, it is unlawful for a Passenger Stage Corporation (PSC) or a Transportation Charter-Party carrier (TCP) of passengers to conduct any operations as a carrier. (California Public Utilities Code §§ 1045, 5379). Unlawful operations are subject to fines and penalties as set forth in the California Public Utilities Code and may include permanent revocation of your operating authority or being permanently barred from receiving an operating authority.

A carrier whose certificate or permit is suspended due to failing to pass a vehicle inspection by the California Highway Patrol (CHP) (California Public Utilities Code § 5378.5, Commission Resolution TL-18336) may obtain a reinspection of its terminal and vehicles by the CHP by submitting a written request for reinstatement to CPUC and paying a reinstatement fee of one thousand dollars (\$1,000). (California Public Utilities Code § 5378.5(b)). Upon receipt of a written recommendation from CHP to suspend a carrier's operating authority, a carrier may request a hearing of the suspension by making a written request to CPUC and the CHP showing cause why the suspension should not be continued.

If your suspension is due to failing to maintain adequate insurance, you must contact your insurance provider to reinstate your policy on-file with the CPUC.

TCP Z PERMIT

The above-named Carrier, having made written application to the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California for a certificate to operate as a CHARTER-PARTY CARRIER OF PASSENGERS, pursuant to Sections 5351 through 5420 of the Public Utilities Code, is granted this certificate authorizing the transportation of passengers by motor vehicle over the public highways of the State of California as a CHARTER-PARTY CARRIER OF PASSENGERS, as defined in said Code, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. This permit is issued pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 5384(a).
- 2. No vehicle or vehicles shall be operated by said Carrier unless adequately covered by a public liability and property damage insurance policy or surety bond as required by Public Utilities Code Section 5392.
- Said Carrier shall comply with all Commission orders, decisions, rules, directions, and requirements governing the operations of said Carrier including General Order Series 115 and 157 and shall remit to the Commission the Transportation Reimbursement Fee required by Public Utilities Code Section 403.
- 4. All vehicles operated under this permit shall comply with the requirements of the Motor Carrier Safety Section of the California Highway Patrol. No vehicle shall be operated unless it is named in the Carrier's most recent equipment list on file with this Commission. Written amendments to the equipment list shall be filed within ten days of the date the vehicle is put into or pulled out of service.
- 5. This permit is subject to amendment, modification, suspension or revocation as provided in the Public Utilities Code and in Commission Resolutions PE-498, PE-501, and TL-18336.
- 6. This permit may not be sold, assigned, leased, or otherwise transferred or encumbered without Commission authorization.
- 7. This permit does not authorize the Carrier to conduct operations on the property of or into any airport unless such operation is authorized by the airport authority involved.
- 8. This permit does not authorize round-trip sightseeing tour service.
- 9. The use of top lights and/or taxi meters in all vehicles operated under this permit is prohibited (D. 82-05-069).
- 10. This permit expires 2026-06-08. It may be renewed every three (3) years upon submission and approval of a renewal application. This renewal application should be submitted 90-days prior to the expiration date.

Dear Ms. Barone:

The California Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) Consumer Protection and Enforcement Division (CPED) Transportation Enforcement Branch (TEB) is currently reviewing the Commission's records for intrastate transportation carriers that are regulated by the Commission.

Public Utilities Code Section 5389 authorizes the Commission and its staff to have access at any time to the land, buildings, or equipment of a charter-party carrier of passengers used in connection with the operation of its business and may inspect the accounts, books, papers, and documents of the carrier.

General Order 157-E, Part 6.01 specifically states in part that every carrier shall institute and maintain in its offices a set of records which reflect information as to the transportation services performed, including waybills, driver records, and safety and maintenance records including copies of all lease and sub-carrier agreements. Such records shall be maintained for a minimum period of three years.

Pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 5389, the Commission is requesting a review of the Charter-Party intrastate transportation records for Carefree Natomas Limited Partnership. Failure to provide access to records is a misdemeanor punishable by a maximum of \$5,000, or by imprisonment in a county jail not exceeding one year, or by both fine and imprisonment, where each violation is a separate and distinct offense (Public Utilities Code Section 2110).

We are requesting that you present your documents listed below in electronic form for the period covering <u>April 16, 2022 through June 7, 2023</u>. Please scan the following documents and email a copy to Eric Ow at <u>eric.ow@cpuc.ca.gov</u> by August 31, 2023.

- 1. Daily Driver's log, vehicle safety and maintenance records,
- Your Public Liability and Property Damage insurance (PL&PD) policy showing schedule of vehicles and drivers insured,
- 3. Your Workers' Compensation (WKCP) insurance policy,
- 4. List of all sub-carriers and agreements,

- 5. Agreement with your Drug Consortium and a list of all drivers enrolled showing dates added and/or deleted,

- 8. Other Fictitious Business Names (FBN) doing business as (dba),
- 9. All pre-employment and random drug test results for all your drivers.

CPED reserves the right to amend, add to or revise this Data Request in the future if necessary. Any responsive records provided by you that have been properly labeled and submitted as confidential will be treated as such, under Public Utilities Code Section 583 (see also General Order 66-D). Confidential documents will not be released to the public except as required by law following a Public Records Request and redaction of confidential material.
