VIOLATIONS

You are hereby cited with having violated sections of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and a California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) General Order (G.O.) as described below. These violations occurred on February 8, 2025.

- (1) Failed to enroll one (1) driver in the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Employer Pull Notice (EPN) Program in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5374(a)(1)(D), G.O. 157-E Part 5.02, and the California Vehicle Code (CVC) Section 1808.1. **[1 count]**
- (2) Engaged one (1) driver without workers' compensation insurance in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5378.1. **[1 count]**

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above violations are documented in the attached Investigation Report, which consists of carrier's records and substantiating documents obtained from other sources.

RESPONSE

TEB used the Penalty Assessment Methodology adopted in Resolution M-4846 and considered mitigating and exacerbating factors in setting the fine.

You are hereby called upon to answer this citation on or before September 8, 2025. By way of such answer, you may either:

- (1) Pay a fine of \$4,000 pursuant to Pub. Util. Code Section 5378. Submit your check or money order payable to California Public Utilities Commission using the attached *Citation Agreement*. Upon payment, the fine will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund and the Commission staff will deem the matter closed, **or**
- (2) Contact the Supervisor below to make payment arrangements, **or**
- (3) Contest this Citation by filing an Appeal. See attached document "*How to File an Appeal and Instructions for Filing a Notice of Appeal and Certificate of Service for a Citation Appeal.*"

If you fail to respond by September 8, 2025, you will be in default and will have forfeited your right to appeal the Citation. In addition, your operating authority will be immediately suspended and may be subsequently revoked pursuant to Resolution ALJ-187. The Commission may also act through a civil or criminal proceeding to recover any unpaid fine and ensure compliance with applicable statutes and Commission orders.

INTRODUCTION

On February 8, 2025, Transportation Enforcement Branch (TEB) staff were conducting a safety compliance inspection during a Ports America Joint Field Operation with the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) and LA Port Police. On February 21, 2025, TEB Enforcement Analyst, Mary Sekyi-Appiah, was assigned to investigate the operations and practices of Polytech Enterprises, LLC dba Shuttle 2000 (Polytech Enterprises, LLC).

VIOLATIONS

The investigation for February 8, 2025, through August 12, 2025, disclosed violations of the following provisions of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and a Commission General Order (GO):

- **Failed to enroll one (1) driver in the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Employer Pull Notice (EPN) Program in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5374(a)(1)(D), G.O. 157-E Part 5.02, and the California Vehicle Code (CVC) Section 1808.1 [1 count].**

On February 8, 2025, TEB staff were conducting a safety compliance inspection during a Ports America Joint Field Operation with the LADOT and LA Port Police. Employee-driver [REDACTED] (CDL: [REDACTED]) was observed operating in a 9-seat white 2012 Ford Van (license plate [REDACTED], VIN [REDACTED]) with PSC 13879 affixed to the sides of the van.

On August 1, 2025, a Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Employer Pull Notice program (EPN) search of requestor code [REDACTED] showed only one driver enrolled (Falaksher Ali Hameed, Owner, CDL: [REDACTED]). Driver [REDACTED] was not enrolled under Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Employee Pull Notice (EPN) requestor code [REDACTED] [Attachment 1].

- **Engaged one (1) driver without workers' compensation insurance in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5378.1 [1 count].**

On February 8, 2025, TEB staff, Mary Sekyi-Appiah, observed driver [REDACTED] (CDL: [REDACTED]) operating in a 9-seat white 2012 Ford Van (license plate [REDACTED], VIN [REDACTED]) with PSC 13879 affixed to the sides of the van. TEB staff, Mary Sekyi-Appiah, issued an Inspection Observation Report to [REDACTED] since Polytech Enterprises, LLC did not have workers' compensation (WKCP) insurance in effect and on file with the Commission [**Attachment 2**].

On March 14, 2025, TEB staff, Mary Sekyi-Appiah, sent a data request to Falaksher Ali Hameed, Owner requesting waybills (1/27/25-2/17/25), WKCP records, public liability and property damage (PL&PD) records and drug/alcohol consortium records [**Attachment 3**].

On April 11, 2025, Falaksher Ali Hameed, Owner, sent Mary Sekyi-Appiah two Certificates of Liability Insurance. One Certificate was for a WKCP policy ([REDACTED]), Effective: 9/15/24-9/15/25, listing 2 drivers ([REDACTED]) and a Certificate for a PL&PD policy listing two 2012 Ford vans (VIN [REDACTED] and VIN [REDACTED]) [**Attachment 4**].

On August 7, 2025, I contacted [REDACTED] and requested WKCP records. On August 11, 2025, [REDACTED] sent me a Notice of Cancellation letter advising the WKCP policy was cancelled on October 20, 2024, for non-payment of premium [**Attachment 5**].

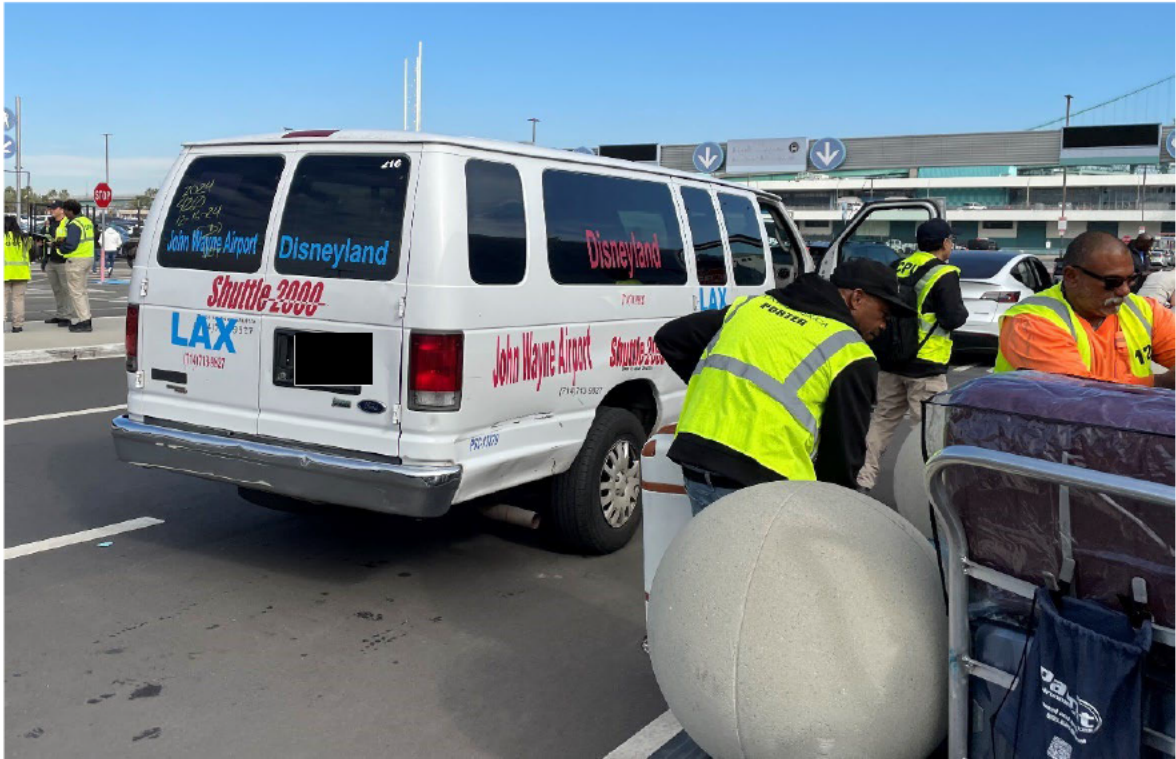

Dear Hameed Falaksher Ali:

The California Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) Consumer Protection and Enforcement Division (CPED) Transportation Enforcement Branch (TEB) is currently reviewing the Commission's records for intrastate transportation carriers that are regulated by the Commission.

Public Utilities Code Section 5389 authorizes the Commission and its staff to have access at any time to the land, buildings, or equipment of a charter-party carrier of passengers used in connection with the operation of its business and may inspect the accounts, books, papers, and documents of the carrier.

General Order 157-E, Part 6.01 specifically states in part that every carrier shall institute and maintain in its offices a set of records which reflect information as to the transportation services performed, including waybills, driver records, and safety and maintenance records including copies of all lease and sub-carrier agreements. Such records shall be maintained for a minimum period of three years.

Pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 5389, the Commission is requesting a review of the Charter-Party intrastate transportation records for Jet Limousines & Transportation. Failure to provide access to records is a misdemeanor punishable by a maximum of \$5,000, or by imprisonment in a county jail not exceeding one year, or by both fine and imprisonment, where each violation is a separate and distinct offense (Public Utilities Code Section 2110).

We are requesting that you present your documents listed below in electronic form. Please scan the following documents and email a copy to mary.sekyi-appiah@cpuc.ca.gov by April 4, 2025.

1. Waybills for all intrastate TCP transportation, including transportation performed as Polytech Enterprise, LLC in California for the period of January 27 to February 17, 2025.
 2. Evidence of current Workers Compensation Insurance coverage, with employee list and classifications, for both authorities.
 3. Your current public liability and property damage insurance policy showing schedule of vehicles and drivers insured.
 4. All pre-employment and random drug test results for all your drivers within the last six (6) months
- CPED reserves the right to amend, add to or revise this Data Request in the future if necessary.

Any responsive records provided by you that have been properly labeled and submitted as confidential will be treated as such under Public Utilities Code Section 583 (see also General Order 66-D). Confidential documents will not be released to the public except as required by law following a Public Records Request and redaction of confidential material.






