VIOLATIONS

You are hereby cited with having violated sections of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and a California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) General Order (G.O.) as described below. These violations occurred on June 5, 2025.

- (1) Operated as a charter-party carrier without authority in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5371 **[1 count]**

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above violations are documented in the attached Investigation Report, which consists of the carrier's records and substantiating documents obtained from other sources.

RESPONSE

TEB used the Penalty Assessment Methodology adopted in Resolution M-4846 and considered mitigating and exacerbating factors in setting the fine.

You are hereby called upon to answer this citation on or before June 28, 2026. By way of such answer, you may either:

- (1) Pay a fine of \$1,500 pursuant to P.U. Code Section 5378. (Submit your check or money order payable to California Public Utilities Commission using the attached *Citation Agreement*. Upon payment, the fine will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund, and the Commission staff will deem the matter closed, **or**
- (2) Contact the Supervisor below to make payment arrangements, **or**
- (3) Contest this Citation by filing an Appeal. See attached document "*How to File an Appeal and Instructions for Filing a Notice of Appeal and Certificate of Service for a Citation Appeal.*"

If you fail to respond by June 28, 2026, you will be in default and will have forfeited your right to appeal the Citation. In addition, your operating authority will be immediately suspended and may be subsequently revoked pursuant to Resolution ALJ-187. The Commission may also act through a civil or criminal proceeding to recover any unpaid fine and ensure compliance with applicable statutes and Commission orders.

INTRODUCTION

On June 5, 2026, I was assigned to investigate Oscar Omar Gomez Rengifo (hereinafter referred to as Oscar). On June 5, 2026, California Highway Patrol (CHP) Officer Leviste (Badge#18371) stopped a white Toyota Camry vehicle license plate [REDACTED] for High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) violation at Oakland Bay Bridge. During the investigation, CHP Officer Tam (Badge# 18053) was notified that driver Oscar was utilizing another individual's Lyft driver account to conduct transportation business on Transportation Network Company (TNC) platform. As a result, his vehicle was impounded by the CHP [Attachment 1].

VIOLATIONS

The investigation for the date of June 5, 2026, disclosed violations of the following provisions of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and Commission General Order (G.O.):

- **Operated as a charter-party carrier without authority in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5371. [1 count]**

According to the CHP investigation report, on June 5, 2026, CHP Officer Leviste conducted a traffic stop of vehicle license plate [REDACTED] for an HOV lane violation. During the stop, Officer Leviste observed that the driver, Oscar, was providing transportation services through the Lyft platform and was transporting one passenger, [REDACTED]. Officer Leviste also determined that Oscar's driver's license did not match the driver information displayed on the Lyft waybill. As a result, Officer Leviste notified CHP Officer Tam, and Officer Tam took over the investigation.

During the investigation, Officer Tam confirmed that Oscar's driver's license ([REDACTED]) did not match the driver information listed on the Lyft waybill [Attachment 2]. The waybill identified the Lyft account holder as Christian Rivera, driver's license number [REDACTED] [Attachments 1 and 3].

Oscar admitted that the Lyft account belonged to his friend, Christian Rivera. Oscar stated that the account was configured so that Lyft earnings were deposited onto a Lyft debit card, which Oscar subsequently used to access the funds [Attachment 1].

Additionally, the passenger waybill provided by [REDACTED] confirmed that the trip was arranged through the Lyft platform and identified Christian Rivera as the driver. The waybills showed a pick-up location [REDACTED] [Attachment 3 & 4].

Based on these findings, Officer Tam notified California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) Field Enforcement Unit Supervisor Shirley Lei of the TNC violations. After reviewing the information, Supervisor Shirley Lei authorized the impoundment of the vehicle **[Attachment 1]**. Subsequently, I submitted a Request for Impound Form (CHP 180) to CHP Officer Tam requesting the impoundment of vehicle license plate [REDACTED]. The vehicle was thereafter impounded by CHP **[Attachment 5]**.

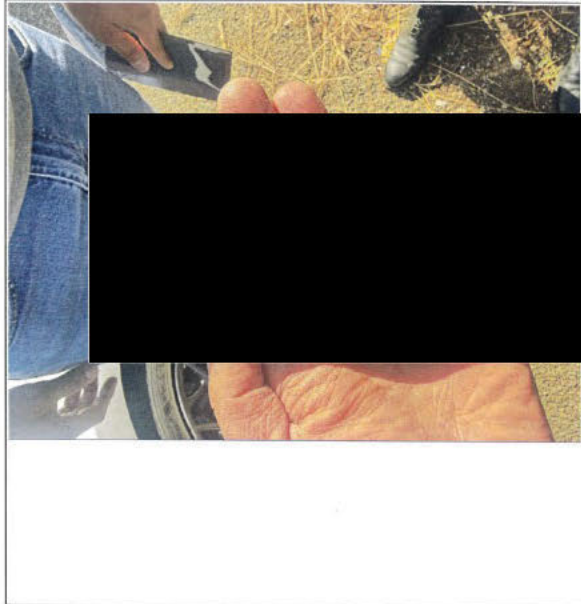

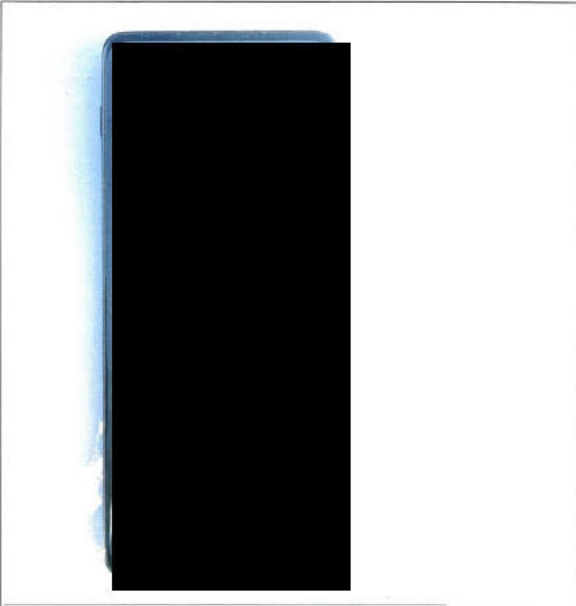

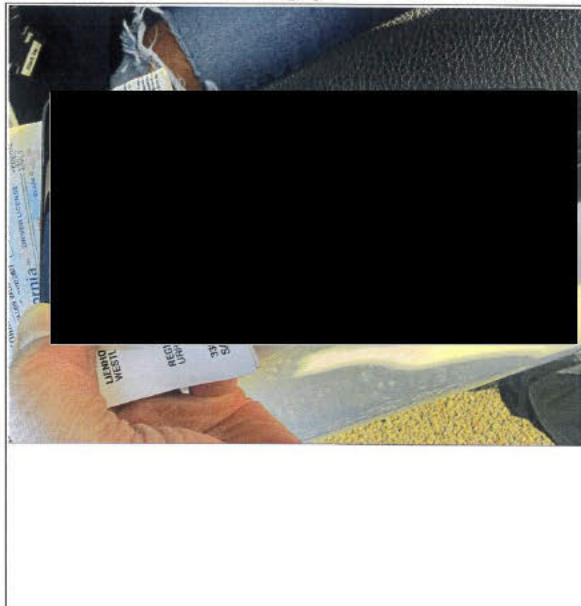
Lyft Driver Profile A

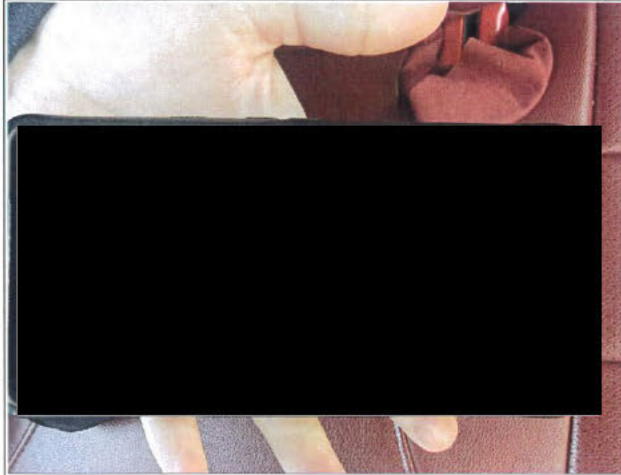


Lyft Driver Ride Detail

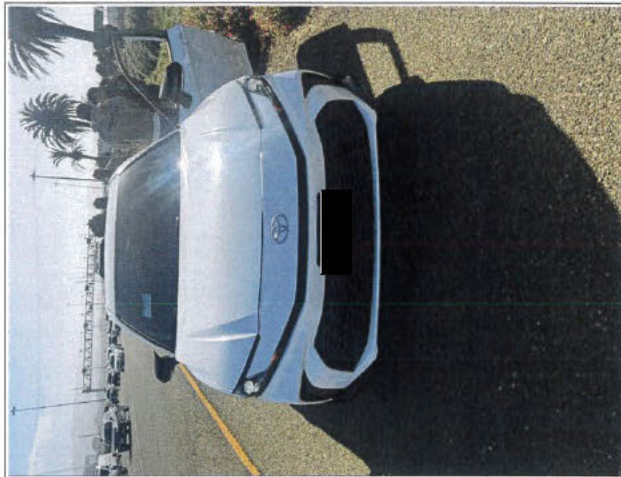
Passenger Ride Detail Screen

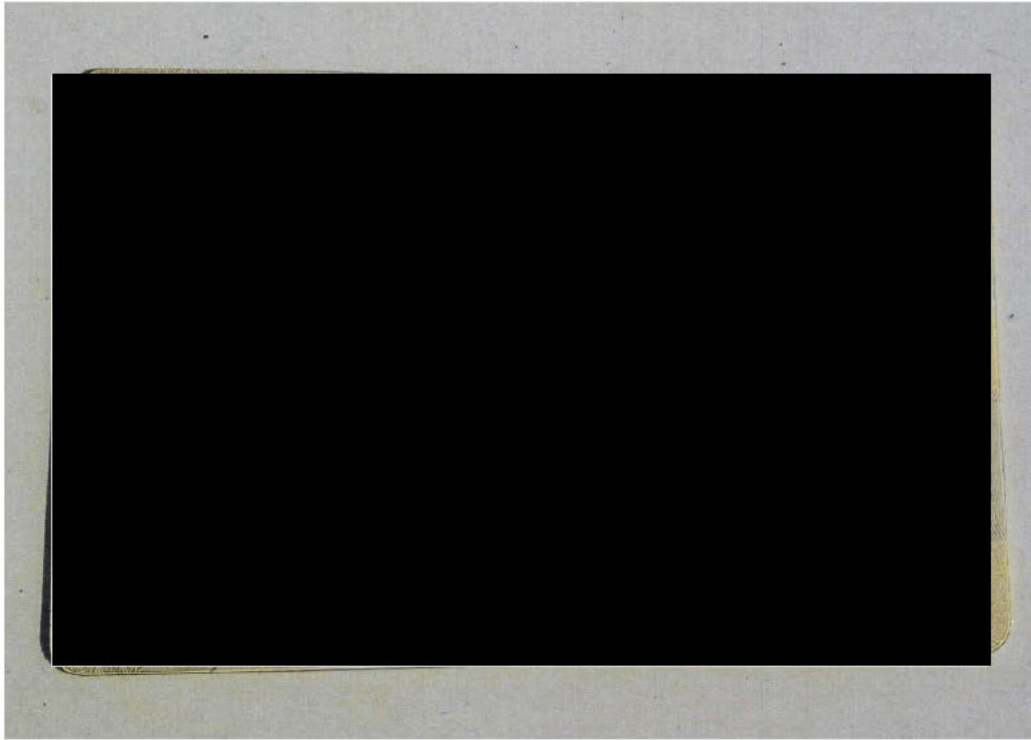

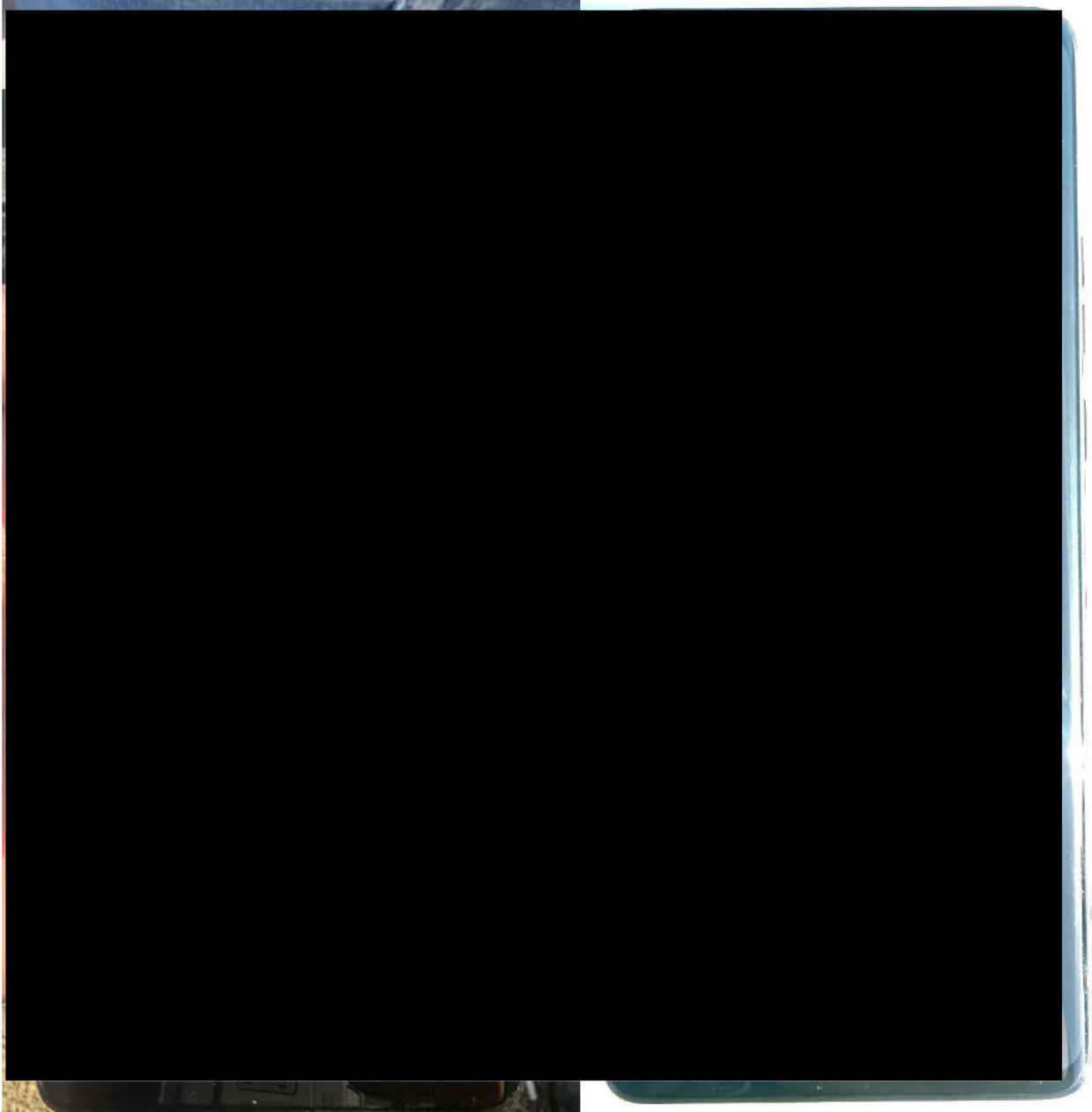
