CCA and ESP Formation Status Report

This report provides a status update on the registration, expansion, and deregistration of Community Choice Aggregators (CCA) and Electric Service Providers (ESP).

CCA Launches and Expansions in 2026

Four CCAs expanded in 2025, two are expanding in 2026, and two are expanding in 2027. Two CCAs filed expansion plans by the Jan 1, 2026 deadline, and six CCAs have active pending expansions that were certified in previous years.

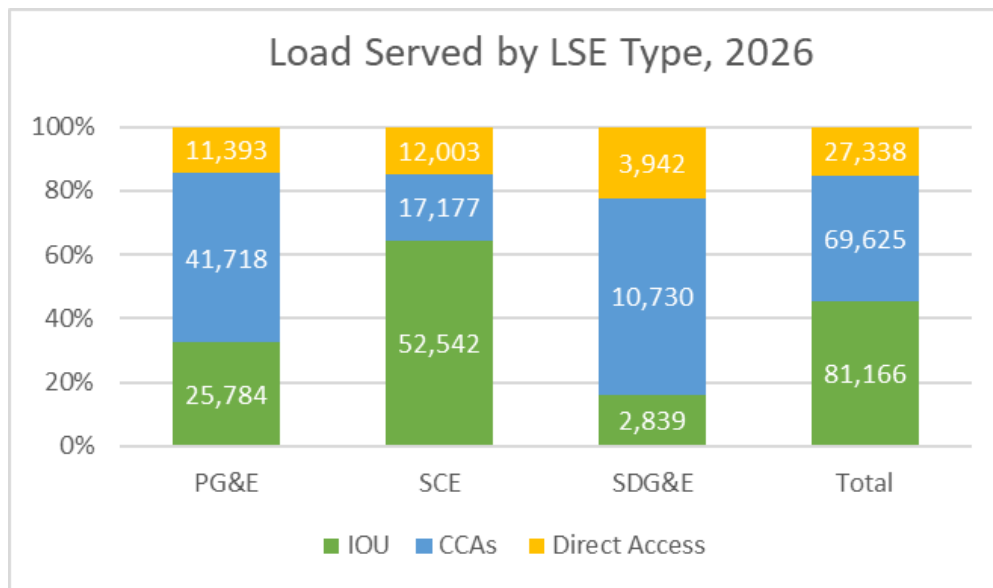

Postponed or Deregistered CCAs

There were no additional CCAs that deregistered or postponed their launch in 2025. The City of Huntington Beach departed from the OCPA and returned to SCE in 2024. While the Irvine City Council voted at the end of 2024 to withdraw from the OCPA in 2025, it subsequently voted in September 2025 to rescind that withdrawal and continue with OCPA³.

Registered ESPs

At the beginning of 2025 there were 17 registered ESPs. Brookfield Renewables Marketing US LLC deregistered on April 8, 2025. Volt Energy LLC's registered as a new ESP on November 4, 2025. Of the 17 ESPs, six of them did not serve load in 2024 and continue to not serve load in 2025. ESP load is deemed market-sensitive confidential data.
