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He has headed more than 70 consultancy and research projects, and has participated in more than 120. He has worked and lectured extensively on the operation, planning and regulation of natural gas and electricity systems, as well as on the regulation of electric and natural gas systems, rate design and integration of Distributed Energy Resources. In these topics he has been a consultant for governments, international institutions, industrial associations, and utilities in many countries.

Prof. Reneses has published more than 100 papers and book chapters in national and international journals, and conference proceedings. He has been lecturing on Electricity tariffs and Distribution regulation in the Florence School of Regulation and Comilllas University. He also has been teaching Statistics and Energy and Sustainability for several years at the School of Engineering.

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
