



Integrated Resource Planning Workshop on the Reliable and Clean Power Procurement Program (RCPPP) Staff Proposal

On May 16, 2025, from 9:00am – 1:00pm, Energy Division Staff will host a public webinar on the Reliable and Clean Power Procurement Program Staff Proposal issued in Rulemaking (R.) 20-05-003. The goal of RCPMP is to establish a long-term procurement framework in the CPUC's Integrated Resource Planning (IRP) process that, in combination with the Resource Adequacy (RA) and Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) programs, could improve the process for Load Serving Entities (LSEs) to procure their share of the resources needed to meet electric system reliability and greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reduction goals at least cost.
