Background:

Rulemaking 19-09-009 facilitates the commercialization and deployment of microgrids while prioritizing system, public, and worker safety and avoiding shifting costs between ratepayers. On September 12, 2019, the Commission initiated this Rulemaking to design a framework surrounding the commercialization of microgrids associated with Senate Bill (SB) 1339 (Stern, 2018), as well as to account for the Commission's commitment toward utilizing additional technologies and activities that may be useful for achieving overall resiliency goals.

As part of the rulemaking, the CPUC is organizing a working group to facilitate thoughtful and informed discussions to continue to support the goal of resiliency and the commercialization of microgrids. Specifically, the RMWG will further explore the issues identified in the proceeding thus far which may include but not limited to the standardized metrics for measuring resiliency and reliability values, CAISO wholesale market, critical facilities, and other topics. The topics may be subject to change and reprioritization as the discussions evolve over the course of the working group meetings.

Purpose of the Meeting:

CPUC staff will define the RMWG goals, discuss logistics such as format and frequency, and review priority topics. After each of the CPUC staff presentations, there will be group discussions to answer any questions attendees may have to ensure a common understanding of the RMWG's objectives. Additionally, the kick-off meeting will lay the foundation the discussion of microgrid tariff for future working group meetings.
