

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON
QUARTERLY DISADVANTAGED COMMUNITIES GREEN TARIFF
AND COMMUNITY SOLAR GREEN TARIFF PROGRAMS REPORT
FOR FOURTH QUARTER 2020

Background

Southern California Edison Company (“SCE”) hereby submits its first Disadvantaged Communities Green Tariff (“DAC-GT”) and Community Solar Green Tariff (“CSGT”) quarterly report in accordance with Resolution E-4999 (“Resolution”), issued June 3, 2019.¹ Ordering Paragraph (“OP”) 1(f) states:

“Once an IOU has completed its first RFO or initiated customer enrollment, whichever occurs first, within 30 Calendar Days after the end of each calendar quarter, PG&E, SCE, and SDG&E shall file a report in R.14-07-002, or a successor proceeding, and serve the same report on that service list, for the previous quarter and cumulatively, with the following minimum information for the DAC-GT and CSGT programs: capacity procured, capacity online, and customers subscribed. The quarterly reports should also identify the DACs in which DAC-GT or CSGT project is located and list the number of customers participating in each program in each DAC within a utility’s service territory. Finally, the quarterly reports must include the number of customers who have successfully enrolled in CARE and FERA in the process of signing up for the DAC-GT or CSGT programs.”²

Decision 18-06-027 (“Decision”) also specifies that utilities work with the Energy Division (“ED”) on reporting requirements and that the ED may modify such requirements as necessary.³ As specific reporting requirements were not designated in the Decision, the Resolution provides standardized reporting requirements to participating investor-owned utilities that include a quarterly Disadvantaged Communities Green Tariff (“DAC-GT”) and Community Solar Green Tariff (“CSGT”) programs progress report with enrollment and subscription details by the program.⁴ This filing is the quarterly report described in the Resolution.

Since SCE completed its earliest RFO in October 2020, this quarterly report covers October 1-December 31, 2020.

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Quarterly Disadvantaged Communities Green Tariff and Community Solar Green Tariff Programs Report Of Southern California Edison For Period Fourth Quarter 2020

Pursuant to Decision 18-06-027 (“Decision”) and in accordance with Resolution E-4999, Southern California Edison Company (“SCE”) hereby files this report on the Disadvantaged Communities Green Tariff (“DAC-GT”) and Community Solar Green Tariff (“CSGT”) programs for the period October-December 2020.

SCE’s DAC-GT (also referred to as “Green Saver Program”) has a program capacity allocation of 56.5 megawatts (MW). This program provides a 20% bill discount to CARE or FERA-eligible customers located in Disadvantaged Communities (DACs), defined as the top 25% most impacted census tracts statewide and 22 census tracts in the highest 5 percent of CalEnviroScreen's Pollution Burden, but do not have an overall CalEnviroScreen score because of unreliable socioeconomic or health data. CSGT (also referred to as “Local Green Saver Program”) has a program capacity allocation of 14.63 MW and provides a 20% electric bill discount to low-income and non-low-income customers who are located within an eligible census tract and within a specified distance from the community solar project built under the program.

On February 27, 2020, SCE launched its first DAC-GT and CSGT solicitation, resulting in ED approval of a CSGT project in October. Table 1 summarizes, for each program, the total procured and online solar project capacity, customers subscribed count, and CARE/FERA enrollments that occurred as a result of DAC-GT or CSGT enrollment. To date, SCE has procured 3 MW of capacity for the CSGT program and 0 MW for the DAC-GT program.

For this report, “Customers Subscribed” is defined as customers for which capacity has been assigned in either the DAC-GT or CSGT programs. Customers who are on the waitlist are not counted as being subscribed to a program. There are also zero enrollments into the CARE/FERA program since there are no waitlist or enrolled customers in both programs during this reporting period.

Table 2 details the project(s) that have been procured to date, and the project characteristics, including project name, what program the project was procured for, the DAC census tract number, and the project capacity. Currently, there is one (1) project for the CSGT program and zero (0) projects for the DAC-GT program. The CSGT project, Visalia CSG, is estimated to begin delivery first quarter of 2022.

Table 3 displays the cumulative number of active customers participating in each program as of December 31, 2020. Note that the census tract numbers displayed do not cover the entire SCE territory at this time since we do not have an approved DAC-GT project. Instead, the table reflects the census tracts that are currently eligible to participate in the CSGT program. As noted in the table, from October - December 2020, we have zero (0) enrollments for both the CSGT project and the DAC-GT.

The number of subscriptions is zero for the DAC-GT program because SCE does not have an approved DAC-GT project at this time. With regards to the CSGT program, SCE began accepting

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subscription and waitlist requests on October 26, 2020. There are also zero subscriptions to the CSGT program as of December 31, 2020.
