#### **Internal Program Activities**

Lodi Gas Storage L.L.C.'s (LGS) Supplier Diversity program is administered jointly by the Senior Compliance Manager, Superintendent of U.S. Operations, and U.S. Operations personnel. The parent company for LGS continues to be Rockpoint Gas Storage, who in turn is owned by Brookfield Infrastructure. The LGS Ops group reports directly to the Vice President (VP) of Ops for Rockpoint. During CY2023, LGS applied a disciplined approach to spending, with management and senior members making key purchasing decisions. The Ops group was made aware of the importance of G.O. #156 program and utilization of diverse suppliers/contractors. Both LGS and Wild Goose Storage (WGS) are under the same Brookfield ownership umbrella. A concentrated effort was made on both LGS/WGS' behalf to communicate and incorporate diverse suppliers/contractors within their spend requirements. The facility continues to be fully committed to the development and adherence of G.O. #156 Supplier Diversity Program goals. The Senior Compliance Manager has reviewed the Clearinghouse information in regards to diverse business spend.

Lodi Gas Storage had a slightly higher percent spent on diverse businesses in comparison to last year (6.88% in CY2023 vs. 6.34% in CY2022), but the overall dollar amount spent on diverse businesses was slightly lower (\$607,120 in CY2023 vs. \$629,023 in CY2022). Gas Storage project work tends to be very specialized with less diverse companies available that provide desired products/services, but Lodi Gas Storage was able to utilize one diverse vendor in this area. Lodi Gas Storage expects higher capital expenditures until the end of calendar year 2026, due to well work that's required to be completed to meet State regulatory requirements. Efforts continued in utilizing diverse companies with day to day operations, and we believe this initiative was successful.

Lodi Gas Storage is expecting equivalent diverse business spend in CY2024, in comparison to the CY2023 actual spend values. Overall we're anticipating to achieve a 6.00% target in CY2024.

#### Internal program activities

Lodi Gas Storage operates two gas storage facilities in Northern California; with the main facility located in San Joaquin County and one facility located in Solano County. Continued efforts were made to reduce operating costs as a way to offset low commodity pricing, and resulting revenue. The downturn in the petroleum industry, as a result of lower commodity pricing, has caused businesses in the area to close shop and move elsewhere. Purchasing options have become even more limited than in the past.

Due to the limited number of purchases that are made by Lodi Gas Storage, the employment of a full time procurement specialist is not justified. The Senior Compliance Manager, Superintendent, U.S. Operations, and operations staff will continue to work diligently in seeking new diverse companies that can support Lodi Gas Storage's needs. Lodi Gas Storage will continue to network with the Wild Goose Storage operation on new/potential diverse business enterprises.

In the area of capacity building, Lodi Gas Storage, as a small utility has only so much leverage to be able to affect change in this area. The specialized nature of some of the equipment as well as the processes unique to gas storage make it difficult in some instances to be able to spread out the supplier base. When undertaking large development/capital projects at Lodi Gas Storage, it typically necessitates the use of high capacity equipment, and unique technical skills/contractor labor. Goods and services that aren't readily available from diverse companies. The proprietary nature of our business definitely limits our ability to be more aggressive in this area. That being said, Lodi Gas Storage continues to investigate diverse companies in the area to see if they'd be a possible fit for future use.

Lodi Gas Storage runs the Supplier Diversity Program jointly between the Calgary Head Office and the facility. The ability for Lodi Gas Storage to expand its mandate in this area requires both local and Head Office support. As discussed earlier, Rockpoint Gas Storage management have been given an overview of the G.O. #156 program, and the associated importance. We continue to focus our efforts upon doing what we can to expand the supplier base in the Lodi Gas Storage area as well as increasing business ties with the small and relatively non-diverse business community. We are aware that this is a worthy goal and will continue to strive in making progress in this area with the resources that we have at our disposal.

#### External program activities

Lodi Gas Storage will make an effort to continue to support programs related to Supplier Diversity.
