TRIBAL CONSULTATION

On tribal broadband needs & solutions, and a
proposed tribal land transfer policy

The California Public Utilities Commission is now considering a proposed land transfer policy requiring Investor Owned Utilities to notify the appropriate California tribe(s) at the time the utility determines it will dispose of surplus properties or retained land located in or adjacent to a tribe's territory. This policy adopts a preference for the transfer of non-Federal Energy Regulatory Commission jurisdictional surplus property, including retained land, to California tribes.

The broadband discussion will center tribal input on current broadband and voice service needs, and models (with funding) to meet these needs.
