**NOTICE OF APPLICATION  
Liberty Utilities (Park Water) Corp.’s Request to Increase Water Rates  
APPLICATION 23-05-004**

**Why am I receiving this notice?**

On May 1, 2023, Liberty Utilities (Park Water) Corp. (Liberty Park Water) filed Application 23-05-004 with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) requesting the authority to increase its authorized cost of capital and rate of return for the period of July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2027. Liberty Park Water’s application requests an increase to the authorized rate of return from 7.35% to 7.87%. Liberty Park Water is requesting this increase due to the increases in the cost of capital that it uses to fund facility improvements needed to provide service to customers. If the CPUC approves this request, Liberty Park Water’s revenues would increase by \$1,240,000, or 2.83%, in 2024.

**Why is Liberty Park Water requesting this rate increase?**

The CPUC requires Liberty Park Water to file a cost of capital application every three years. The authorized cost of capital determines the amount of money Liberty Park Water is allowed to recover in rates as a return on the funds it has invested in utility infrastructure used in providing water service. Liberty Park Water’s proposed cost of capital request for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2027, is summarized in the following table:

**How could this affect my monthly water rates?**

If the proposed application is approved by the CPUC, the average residential customer with a 5/8” x 3/4” meter, using 9.21 CCF (CCF is one hundred cubic feet or 748 gallons) would see a monthly bill increase of \$2.45 (or 2.88%) from \$84.73 to \$87.18, from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2027. The table below excludes applicable taxes and surcharges.

### **How does the rest of this process work?**

This application will be assigned to a CPUC Administrative Law Judge who will consider proposals and evidence presented during the formal hearing process. The Administrative Law Judge will issue a proposed decision that may adopt Liberty Park Water's application, modify it, or deny it. Any CPUC Commissioner may sponsor an alternate decision with a different outcome. The proposed decision, and any alternate decisions, will be discussed and voted upon by the CPUC Commissioners at a public CPUC Voting Meeting.

Parties to the proceeding will review Liberty Park Water's application, including the Public Advocates Office, which is an independent consumer advocate within the CPUC that represents customers to obtain the lowest possible rate for service consistent with reliable and safe service levels.
