Notice of Pacific Power's Rate Increase Request

Pacific Power's (PacifiCorp) Wildfire Expense Memorandum Account Application to the California Public Utilities Commission A.26-02-021

WHAT IS PACIFIC POWER REQUESTING?

Pacific Power is requesting to recover wildfire liabilities and legal expenses associated with the catastrophic Slater (2020) and McKinney (2022) fires in the company's service territory which is estimated to result in a revenue increase of \$34.5 million resulting in a rate increase of \$34.5 million (or 18.8%) PacifiCorp seeks to finance these costs through the issuance of recovery bonds. This would lessen the rate impact to customers compared to traditional utility ratemaking. These costs would be recovered over a 15-year period beginning in 2027. In California, utilities are required to pay for property damage and other costs resulting from a fire caused by utility equipment. This is required even if the utility operated in a prudent manner.

HOW WOULD THIS IMPACT THE AVERAGE RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER?

If Pacific Power's request is approved, the estimated average monthly residential bill of a customer using 850 kilowatt-hours will increase by approximately \$39.17 in 2027. The actual impact will vary based on terms of the bonds, usage and other factors.
