AT&T'S RESPONSE TO AUDIT RELATED TO LA CONSTRUCTION REGION CONDUCTED FEBRUARY 24-28, 2025

I. Records Review – Alleged Violations List

Records Review Alleged Violation #1: AT&T's records indicated that from 2018 to 2024, AT&T completed 5 overhead work orders past AT&T's scheduled due date for corrective action.

AT&T Response:

Without admitting that AT&T violated GO 95, Rule 18, AT&T will endeavor to complete work orders by the due date.

II. Field Inspection – Alleged Violations List

Field Inspection Alleged Violation #1a: AT&T's facilities on the following poles required maintenance:

- Pole 1491729E the AT&T splice box fastener rings were abandoned.
- Pole 608916H the "eye" of the AT&T down guy anchor attached the pole was buried.
- 4852663E service drop is loose and not properly secured to pole.
- 1491732E service drop not properly secured to the pole.

AT&T Response:

- Pole 1491729E: Ticket 1577821 was created for the alleged finding with a due date of 11/1/2027.
- Pole 608916H is not a listed location and there was no record of visiting that pole on the audit. If the auditor meant Pole 608918H: Ticket 1687633 was created for the alleged finding with a due date of 5/7/2030.

- Pole X8634E an AT&T conductor was contacting a third-party communications conductor.
- Pole 1158881E: an AT&T conductor was in contact with a "terminal box" on a third-party communications conductor.
- Pole 608917H: an AT&T conductor was in contact with a third-party communications conductor.

AT&T Response:

- Pole 1492846E: Ticket 1687943 was created for the alleged finding with a due date of 5/6/2030.
- Pole X8634E: Ticket 1687942 was created for the alleged finding with a due date of 5/6/2030.
- Pole 1158881E: Ticket 1687631 was created for the alleged finding with a due date of 5/6/2030.
- Pole 608917H: Ticket 1687635 was created for the alleged finding with a due date of 5/6/2030.

Alleged Field Inspection Violation #3b: Pole 492658E and 2365076E: AT&T conductors had less than 12 inches of vertical clearance from a third-party communications conductor

AT&T Response:

- Pole 492658E is not a listed location for the audit, and AT&T has no record of visiting this pole during the audit. If the auditor meant Pole 4926588E: Ticket 1687384 was created for the alleged finding with a due date of 5/6/2030.
- Pole 2365076E is not a listed location for the audit, and AT&T has no record of visiting this pole during the audit. If the auditor meant Pole 2365066E: Ticket 1687637 was created for the alleged finding with a due date of 5/6/2030.

Alleged Field Inspection Violation #4: The marker (guard) on the down guy wire supporting pole number 149783E was missing.

AT&T Response:

Pole 149783E is not a listed location for the audit, and AT&T has no record of visiting this pole during the audit. If the auditor meant Pole 1491738E: Ticket 1687383 was created for the alleged finding with a due date of 5/6/2030.

Alleged Field Inspection Violation #5: The handhole cover located at 1608 Bruins Street, W. Athens, LA, was not secured.

AT&T Response:

Ticket 1686947 was created for the alleged finding with a due date of 5/6/2026.

Alleged Field Inspection Violation #6: The handhole at 1655 Bruins Street, W. Athens, LA was not sealed to mitigate water intrusion.
