The Safety and Enforcement Division (SED) of the California Public Utilities Commission conducted a **General Order (G.O.)112-F Comprehensive Operation and Maintenance Inspection of Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas)'s Northwest North Coast Natural Gas Distribution Area (Inspection Unit)**, on October 17 through October 21 of 2022 for calendar years 2017 through 2021. SED conduct records review and field inspections of SoCalGas distribution pipeline facilities in Templeton, San Luis Obispo, and Santa Maria districts within the Inspection Unit. SED's staff also reviewed the implementation of the Operator Qualification program, which included field observation of randomly selected individuals performing covered tasks.

SED's staff used the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration's (PHMSA) Inspection Assistance (IA) as a reference guide to conduct this inspection.
