Dear Mr. Gonzalez:

The Safety and Enforcement Division (SED) of the California Public Utilities Commission conducted a G.O. 112-F review and inspection of Gil Ranch Storage's (GRS) Damage Prevention (DP) and Public Awareness (PAP) Programs between October 16 and October 20, 2023. SED staff reviewed GRS's written DP and PAP procedures and records pursuant to G.O. 112-F, Reference Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Parts 191, and 192 and used the Pipeline and Hazardous Material Safety Administration's (PHMSA) Inspection Assistant (IA) as a reference guide to conduct the inspection.

SED's findings are noted in the Post-Inspection Written Preliminary Findings (Summary) which is enclosed with this letter. SED identified two (2) concerns during this inspection. These findings reflect only those procedures and records that SED inspected during the inspection.

Within 30 days of your receipt of this letter, please provide a written response indicating the measures taken by GRS to address the concerns noted in the Summary.

Issue Summary Section 8.4.4 of API RP 1162 states in part:

"As a baseline, the operator should track the number of incidents and consequences caused by third-party excavators. This should include reported near misses..."

Section 8.4 of API RP 1162 establishes requirements for measuring public awareness program effectiveness. SED reviewed GRS documentation showing the tracking of near miss data. This data was not included in GRS's 2022 4-year effectiveness evaluation.

SED recommends that near miss data be included in future public awareness program effectiveness evaluation documents to maintain compliance with section 8.4.4 of API RP 1162.

Issue Summary During this inspection, GRS provided evidence that they had made multiple efforts to reach out to public officials but had not received meaningful feedback from any members of the stakeholder group. GRS's 2022 4-year effectiveness survey stated that GRS had received no survey responses from public officials. GRS stated in the Finding/Corrective Actions section of the report that, "In the future, Gill Ranch will increase outreach with Public Officials, and emphasize the importance of the information for continual improvement of safety and public knowledge at Gill Ranch."

> SED recommends that GRS write and implement specific and actionable plans to increase outreach to public officials to ensure that this finding from their 4-year effectiveness survey is addressed by program improvements.
