As you know, an audit team from the Consumer Protection and Safety Division (CPSD) has been conducting an audit of the Pittsburg Power Plant (Pittsburg) for compliance with General Order 167. Now, CPSD delivers the attached preliminary audit report.

By May 27, 2010, please send us a response to the preliminary audit report, including a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) for the violations listed in Sections 5 and 6 of the report. The CAP should include a description and schedule of the actions Pittsburg plans to take to achieve full and prompt compliance with the Standards. If you believe there are factual or other errors in the preliminary audit report, you may discuss these in your response. Please submit your response electronically, in both Microsoft Word and Adobe Acrobat PDF formats, to Richard W. We will review your response carefully, and if necessary, set up a meeting with you for further discussions.

Please note that although Pittsburg has been given 30 days to respond, Pittsburg has a continuing obligation to comply with all applicable requirements of General Order 167. The 30-day period does not alter this continuing duty.

If you wish to make a claim of confidentiality covering any of the information in the preliminary audit report, please submit a confidentiality request pursuant to Section 15.4 of General Order 167, using the heading "GENERAL ORDER 167 CONFIDENTIALITY CLAIM."
