Purpose:	This Technical Working Group (TWG) session has two purposes, both of which will support the development of the CPUC Staff Proposal in this rulemaking. First, parties will develop the details of implementation for the Level 4 Recommendation identified as “Risk Modeling 3,” which states, “With input from the parties involved, the CPUC should adopt a standard readability factor to be used for RSE calculations.” Second, parties will discuss the following scoping memo question: “Should the Commission consider impacts on environmental and social justice communities, including the extent to which action in this proceeding impacts the achievement of any of the nine goals of the Commission’s Environmental and Social Justice (ESJ) Action Plan?” If so, what are the ways in which we can consider those impacts?
Expected Outcome:	TWG attendees will identify and discuss the merits of adopting a standard readability factor to be used for RSE calculations, which will support development of the CPUC Staff Proposal in the Rulemaking. Moreover, attendees will identify ways in which to measure investment in ESJ communities and make priorities about risk reduction in those communities more transparent.
