

Background

- In first Safety Model Assessment Proceeding (S-MAP)
 A.15-05-002 et al, parties reached settlement on basic requirements on how to identify and evaluate key risks and perform mitigation analysis for use in RAMP and GRC.
- S-MAP decision D.19-04-020 adopted Settlement Agreement.
- PG&E will file next RAMP (TY2023) in June/2020.
- PG&E's TY2023 RAMP will be affected by S-MAP Settlement Agreement.
