Subject: Authorized Balancing Account Outstanding Balances (A)

In Response to Ms. Rocha's July 30, 2018 email (as clarified by her August 8 email) California American Water (Cal-Am) identifies each balancing account consistent with the following criteria:

(1) Balancing accounts with a quarter-end balance with more than a 10-percent differential from the balancing account's authorized revenue amount.

RESPONSE: Cal-Am interprets "authorized revenue amount" to be the most recent amount authorized for recovery in Cal-Am's last General Rate Case (D.18-12-021), or the most recently reviewed balance as designated below. In instances where "authorized revenue amounts" were not provided in the Appendices to D.18-12-021, Cal-Am has relied on the Decision work papers provided by Water Division. The following table lists the accounts with a guarter-end balance with more than a 10% differential from the "authorized revenue amount."
