# California Public Utilities Commission California-American Water Company (Cal-Am) General Rate Case – D.18-12-021 LA Duarte District

What Does D.18-12-021 Authorize for Cal-Am?

#### Increases in Operating Costs in the Following Areas Required Increases in Utility Revenue to be Recovered in Rates:

- Water supply costs (purchased water, pump taxes, purchased power, Chemicals)
- Water infrastructure: Mains replacement, plant improvements
- Payroll
- Other Rent, Insurance, Purchased services

# **Cost Increases Require the Following Increase in Utility Revenue:**

- 2018: \$2.90 million (9.18%) above authorized 2017 revenues
- 2019\*: \$1.59 million (4.63%) above authorized 2018 revenues
- 2020<sup>\*</sup>: \$1.44 million (4.00%) above authorized 2019 revenues

\*Revenue increases for 2019 and 2020 are estimated using escalation and inflation factors. Actual increases may vary based on current inflation estimates.

#### Cal-Am's 2018 Revenue to be Recovered in Rates - \$9,179,656

#### **Authorized Rate Design Changes:**

• 11% more revenue from Tier 1 consumption

#### 2018 Balancing and Memorandum Account Recovery:

- \$18.9M (8.5%) to be recovered company-wide by surcharge
- \$7.2M (3.2%) tax credit to be refunded company-wide by surcredit

Excluding CPUC fee, City Tax, surcharges and refunds, an average residential customer with a 5/8-inch meter using 9 ccf (1 ccf = 748 gallons) every month will see an increase in their monthly bill from \$31.49 in 2017 to \$35.73 in 2018. The same bill is estimated to be \$37.52 in 2019 and \$39.02 in 2020, resulting in an overall 23.9% rate increase over 3 years.
