

California Water Service Company (Cal Water) General Rate Case – Decision 20-12-007

Bay Area Region

What does D.20-12-007 Authorize for Cal Water?

Utility Revenue – Company Wide (21 Districts):

- Year 2020: \$696.5 million (M)
 - Increase of \$4.43M (0.6%) above authorized 2019 revenues
- Estimated Year 2021*: \$717.4M and Year 2022*: \$738.8M
 O Increase of \$20.9M (3.0%) and \$21.4M (3.0%) respectively

Utility Revenue - <u>Bay Area Region</u>:

- Year 2020: **\$92.0M**
 - Increase of \$4.15M (4.7%) above authorized 2019 revenues
- Estimated Year 2021*: \$95.3M and Year 2022*: \$98.5M
 O Increase of \$3.29M (3.6%) and \$3.16M (3.3%) respectively

Rate Design Changes:

• Revenue Allocation Ratio
