Utility Revenue – Company Wide (21 Districts):

- Year 2020: \$696.5 million (M)
 - o Increase of \$4.43M (0.6%) above authorized 2019 revenues
- Estimated Year 2021*: \$717.4M and Year 2022*: \$738.8M
 - Increase of \$20.9M (3.0%) and \$21.4M (3.0%) respectively

Utility Revenue – <u>Dominguez District</u>:

- Year 2020: \$71.1M
 - o Decrease of \$5.78M (-7.5%) above authorized 2019 revenues
- Estimated Year 2021*: \$72.3M and Year 2022*: \$73.8M
 - Increase of \$1.26M (1.8%) and \$1.47M (2.0%) respectively
