What does D.20-12-007 Authorize for Cal Water?

Utility Revenue – Company Wide (21 Districts):

- Year 2020: \$696.5 million (M)
 - o Increase of \$4.43M (0.6%) above authorized 2019 revenues
- Estimated Year 2021*: \$717.4M and Year 2022*: \$738.8M
 - o Increase of \$20.9M (3.0%) and \$21.4M (3.0%) respectively

Utility Revenue – Kern River Valley District:

- Year 2020: \$7.16M
 - o Increase of **\$0.59M** (9.0%) above authorized 2019 revenues
 - o \$1.78M (19.9%) will be subsidized by other Cal Water Districts
 - Rate Support Fund (RSF) Program
- Estimated Year 2021*: \$7.40M and Year 2022*: \$7.67M
 - Increase of \$0.24M (3.3%) and \$0.27M (3.6%) respectively
