

California Water Service Company (Cal Water) General Rate Case – Decision 20-12-007

Livermore District

What does D.20-12-007 Authorize for Cal Water?

Utility Revenue – Company Wide (21 Districts):

- Year 2020: \$696.5 million (M)
 - Increase of \$4.43M (0.6%) above authorized 2019 revenues
- Estimated Year 2021*: \$717.4M and Year 2022*: \$738.8M
 O Increase of \$20.9M (3.0%) and \$21.4M (3.0%) respectively

Utility Revenue – <u>Livermore District</u>:

- Year 2020: **\$25.2M**
 - <u>Decrease</u> of **\$0.19M** (-0.7%) above authorized 2019 revenues
- Estimated Year 2021*: \$25.9M and Year 2022*: \$26.6M
 - $\odot~$ Increase of \$0.75M (3.0%) and \$0.68M (2.6%) respectively

Rate Design Changes:

Revenue Allocation Ratio
