- Estimated Year 2021*: \$717.4M and Year 2022*: \$738.8M
 - Increase of \$20.9M (3.0%) and \$21.4M (3.0%) respectively

Utility Revenue – Salinas Valley Region:

- Year 2020: \$38.0M
 - O Decrease of \$1.00M (-2.6%) above authorized 2019 revenues
- Estimated Year 2021*: \$39.0M and Year 2022*: \$40.2M
 - Increase of \$1.05M (2.8%) and \$1.17M (3.0%) respectively
