- Year 2020: \$696.5 million (M)
 - o Increase of \$4.43M (0.6%) above authorized 2019 revenues
- Estimated Year 2021*: \$717.4M and Year 2022*: \$738.8M
 - Increase of \$20.9M (3.0%) and \$21.4M (3.0%) respectively

Utility Revenue – Willows District:

- Year 2020: \$3.88M
 - o Increase of \$1.37M (54.8%) above authorized 2019 revenues
 - o \$0.71M (18.3%) will be subsidized by other Cal Water Districts
 - Rate Support Fund (RSF) Program
- Estimated Year 2021*: \$4.04M and Year 2022*: \$4.22M
 - Increase of \$0.16M (4.1%) and \$0.17M (4.3%) respectively
