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R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO
SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE OPERATING AUTHORITIES OF
PASSENGER STAGE CORPORATIONS AND CHARTER PARTY
CARRIERS OF PASSENGERS, FOR LACK OF INSURANCE
AND FAILURE TO FILE TARIFFS AND/OR TIMETABLES,
AND TO PROVIDE FOR REINSTATEMENTS

WHEREAS: passenger stage corporations and charter party carriers of passengers are required by Commission General Orders to maintain a minimum specified amount of liability insurance protection, and have on file with the Commission proof in the form of a current certificate showing that such insurance has been obtained; and

WHEREAS: from time to time some passenger stage corporations and charter party carriers fail to maintain proof of insurance and must have their operating authorities suspended or revoked; and

WHEREAS: from time to time some passenger stage corporations fail to file tariffs and/or timetables required by the Commission; and

WHEREAS: it is necessary for the Commission to act quickly to suspend or revoke a carrier's operating authority;

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Executive Director is authorized, on behalf of the Commission, to suspend or revoke the operating authorities of passenger stage corporations and charter party carriers of passengers for good cause defined as constituting either of the following:

1. Failure to have on file with the Commission evidence of current liability insurance in the amounts and format prescribed by the General Order 101 series for passenger stage corporations or 115 series for charter party carriers.
2. In the case of passenger stage corporations, failure to file tariffs and/or timetables pursuant to the California Public Utilities Code, and in conformance with General Orders 79 and 98 series.

Each such suspension or revocation shall recite that it was issued pursuant to this resolution. Each such order when signed by the Executive Director shall be deemed to be the order of the Commission.


The Executive Director may reinstate operating authorities which have been suspended or revoked pursuant to this resolution, upon written request by the carrier received by the Commission no later than 60 days from the effective date of suspension or revocation. Such reinstatement shall be effected only if the carrier has fully cured the failure giving rise to the revocation and paid a reinstatement fee of \$50.00.

A carrier may appeal any action taken pursuant to this resolution by filing an application with the Commission pursuant to Rules 15 and 42 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

This resolution is effective today.
